Camp Information

Insurance – SIUE Cougars Soccer Camps have purchased secondary insurance coverage for each camper. Primary coverage for all injuries incurred will be the responsibility of the parent or guardians' insurance carrier.

Injuries – An Athletic Trainer will be present during camp. If further medical attention is needed, local hospital facilities in Edwardsville will be utilized. Parents or guardians of campers will be notified as soon as possible of any injury requiring medical treatment.

Residence hall – Campers and Staff for all camps will be housed at the Bluff Hall. Messages may be left for campers at the Bluff Hall Front Desk (618) 650-4253 (an attendant is on duty at the desk 24 hours per day).

Camp Regulations

1. Campers are required to sleep in the rooms that are assigned to them.
2. A \$100.00 fee per key will be assessed to any camper losing their keys(s).
3. A soccer camp requires adequate rest in order to be able to perform at one's maximum potential. All campers are to be in their rooms by the time assigned each day.
4. All sessions will start on time and campers are expected to be in attendance at all sessions.
5. Smoking, alcohol or use of illegal drugs will not be tolerated.
6. Campers are NOT to enter other rooms without permission of those campers.
7. It is not allowed for campers to leave campus or go anywhere on campus without a staff member.
8. Any camper that drives themselves to camp will turn in their keys at registration.
9. Rough play, including loud noise is not permitted in the Residence Halls. DO NOT play with soccer balls in the Residence Hall.

The above regulations are for the protection of the participants and we will make every effort to insure that they are fully enforced. Parents or guardians of those found in violation of these camp rules will be contacted and required to pick up their child immediately!
